Mr Rawlins is a Specialist Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic surgeon with clinical, research and teaching interests across the field of plastic surgery. He has a subspecialty interest in the surgical management of skin cancer and melanoma and is a panel member of the Western Australian Melanoma Advisory Service (WAMAS).

His other clinical and research interests include the use of perforator flaps and free microvascular free flaps in his plastic surgery practice, plastic surgery trauma (including hand surgery) and burns.
